

## GREY SQUIRREL

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO CONTROL GREY SQUIRRELS ON YOUR LAND AND YOU DO NOT NEED A LICENCE TO DO SO

Squirrels are protected by the **Wild Mammal Protection Act 1996**, preventing their **ill treatment** and therefore you must dispatch them humanely. It is illegal to use a bow, crossbow, any explosive other than ammunition for a firearm or a live decoy.

Natural England recommends cage trapping followed by humane dispatch

**Types approved:** Single catch, live catch and spring catch traps (not recommended in domestic places)

- 1. Place traps near closed spaces such as brickwork.
- 2. Bait the trap with whole yellow maize, peanuts, wheat or a mixture. Avoid stocking bird tables while trapping.
- 3. Inspect traps once a day for caught squirrels.
- 4. Dispatch of caught squirrels humanely—run into a sack with a sharp blow to the head or shoot with a suitable licensed weapon.

## **DISPOSAL**

Carcasses should be removed of **discretely** by **burning**, **burying** or **refuse collection** (providing they are wrapped securely).
